Learning Languages

- Make a decorated bookmark with some useful French/German/Spanish words on it.
- Make and write a postcard in French/German/Spanish. Say hello, what your name is, how old you are, something that you like and goodbye.

Where do they speak these languages?

- Draw the flags of two French/German/Spanish-speaking countries. Try to find out what the colours and images on each flag mean and label them.
- Choose a French/German/Spanish-speaking country and make a poster to tell your friends about it.
- Draw/paint a famous tourist attraction in a French/German/Spanish-speaking country.

Who speaks these languages?

- Make a fact file about a famous author who wrote stories or poems in French/German/Spanish.
- Make a fact file about a famous sportsman or sportswoman from a French/German/Spanish-speaking country.
- Make a fact file about a famous French/German/Spanish musician, singer or group.
